- Sports trainers appropriate for activity
- Navy, blue, dark green or black jacket

Alternatively, plain navy items with no logo or markings may be worn:

- Navy tracksuits pants or shorts

Boys PE Uniform [available from Logo'd](#)

All boys P1 - S4

- School blue hoodie, zipper or crew neck sweatshirt with logo
- School blue polo shirt with logo
- Sports trainers appropriate for activity
- Navy, blue, dark green or black jacket

*The following items are available from Logo'd with the school logo.
Alternatively, plain navy items with no logo or markings may be worn:*

- Navy tracksuits pants or shorts

Gateway - S5 and S6

- Pupils in S5 and S6 who have enrolled in the Gateway Programme are members of Cedars School Society. They may optionally replace two items of school uniform with their Cedars School Society equivalents:
 - Cedars School Society tie in place of the tartan school tie - available from the school
 - Cedars School Society polo shirt in place of the school polo shirt in trip uniform situations - not as a replacement for formal uniform. - available on Logo'd
 - Cedars School Society hlaif zip jumper. - available on Logo'd

Uniform and Appearance Rules P1-S6

The wearing of uniform and pupils' appearance are very important matters. Pupils carry the reputation of Cedars School wherever they go in uniform and therefore the uniform must always be worn appropriately and with dignity. School uniform also serves to protect young people from the demands of fashion and ensures a level playing field of uniformity, identity and belonging. These principles underpin our school uniform philosophy and the following additional details and clarifications.

1. Children should wear formal uniform when not on a trip or at PE, which includes their blazers all year round.
2. Shirts must be worn tucked in. Top button and tie must be done up.
3. Items in the colours or style of any professional football team are not allowed.
4. Leggings or running tights of any material should not be worn during the school day for lessons or trips. They *can* be worn during PE coaching or sports sessions.
5. Shoes should be black, plain and formal. A velcro closure is acceptable on formal shoes.
Note: black trainers are not part of the formal uniform.
6. Hats and gloves are acceptable in cold weather but these should not be of a novelty appearance. Baseball caps should not be worn.
7. Children should not wear loose jewellery to school, except for religious reasons.
8. Hair should be in single natural colour (i.e. not dip-dye or Ombré). Long hair should be tied back/braided in situations where safety is a concern (e.g. science labs, PE, trips).
9. Aerosol sprays of any kind are not allowed.
10. Please mark items of clothing with the owner's name.
11. Headphones may be used in class only with the permission of the teacher and must not be worn around the school as an accessory, either on the ears or around the neck.
12. Exceptions to school uniform policy will be considered for pupils with diagnosed sensory difficulties and can be discussed with the Head Teacher.
